
Access Land - Combe Field and Hartslock Nature Reserve

This map shows access land in pale blue, *including the new access strip between Combe Field West and North.* Combe Fields are County Wildlife sites, of note for their lowland chalk grassland. Hartslock is a Site of Special Scientific Interest – both for its lowland beech and yew woodland as well as the chalk grassland.


