

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(THAME 10K ROAD RACE) (SPECIAL EVENT) ORDER 2024**

WHEREAS the Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) is satisfied that vehicular traffic in certain roads in Thame, for road safety reasons should be temporarily prohibited to facilitate the holding of the Thame 10K Road Race on the 30 June (“The Event”). The Council is satisfied that it is not appropriate for the event to take place wholly off road

NOW THEREFORE the Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers make the following Order.

1. Save as provided by Article 2 of this Order, no person shall when and where appropriate signage is in place, other than under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause a vehicle to proceed or wait in:
 - (1) Oxford Road, from the A418 roundabout to Lower High Street, Thame at its junction with Southern Road and
 - (2) the B4012 Thame Eastern By-Pass, between its junctions with the A4129 Kingsey Road and the B4445 Chinnor Road.(“the Sections of Roads”).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause a vehicle to proceed in the Sections of Roads, subject to the safety and progress of the Event if the vehicle is being used:
 - (i) for the purpose of police, fire or ambulance services;
 - (ii) in connection with essential utility or other works in, on or adjacent to the road, or on any land adjacent to the road;
 - (iii) by authorised officials responsible for safety of the event;
 - (iv) for access to property only accessible from the closed sections of road.
3. The prohibition in the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads, Thame) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 1988, insofar as it relates to Chinnor Road and Kingsey Road, shall be suspended for the duration of this event.
4. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Thame 10K Road Race) (Special Event) Order 2024 and shall have effect only on 30 June 2024.
