

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(OXFORD - CANCER RESEARCH UK RACE FOR LIFE)
(SPECIAL EVENT) ORDER 2024**

WHEREAS the Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) is satisfied that traffic in Oxford should be temporarily prohibited from or restricted in various lengths of road in Oxford City to facilitate the holding of the Cancer Research Race for Life (“The event”) on Sunday 30 June 2024 and the Council is satisfied it is not practicable to hold the whole event off road.

NOW THEREFORE the Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers make the following Order:

- 1 “Bus” means a vehicle which is constructed or adapted to carry more than 8 passengers (exclusive of the driver) and a local bus not so constructed or adapted; and a ‘Local Bus’ means a public service vehicle used for the provision of a local service not being an excursion or tour.

‘Taxi’ means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847; and for this order includes Licenced /Private Hire Vehicles defined by S80 Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.

- 2 Save as provided by Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, when appropriate signage is in place, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or the Council, cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order (“the Sections of Road”).
- 3 Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause a vehicle to proceed, subject to the progress of and safety of the event, in any of the Sections of Road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order:
 - a) if the vehicle is being used for the purpose of the police, fire or ambulance services;
 - b) if the vehicle is being used in connection with works to any sewer or to any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or telecommunications in, or in any land adjacent to a Section of Road;
 - c) if the vehicle is being used by an authorised event official in support of and for safety reasons of the event;
 - d) to allow access to premises, to set down or pick up a passenger, or to enable loading or unloading to take place at premises adjacent to the road.
- 4 Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause a vehicle to proceed in the High Street if it is a Bus or Taxi.
- 5 Save as provided by Articles 6 of this Order no person shall, when appropriate signage is in place, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or the Council, cause or permit a vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

- 6 Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order if the vehicle is being used for any of the purposes specified in article 3.
- 7 Save as provided in article 8 of this order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle in a road specified in columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 3 to this Order to proceed in a direction other than that specified opposite to it in column 3 of the said schedule.
- 8 Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause a vehicle to proceed other than in the direction specified if the vehicle is being used for any of the purpose specified in article 3 a) and c) of this order.
- 9 The prohibitions imposed by articles 2, 5 and 7 of this order shall apply in relation to any part of the Sections of Road to such extent and at such times as there are in place traffic signs within the meaning of section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating that such prohibition is in operation at that part.
- 10 The Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (Central Area) (Traffic Management) (Consolidation) Order 2003 (as amended) shall be partly suspended. That is to say, that vehicles prohibited by articles 36 and 45 of that Order may be permitted access along Turl Street, and by article 13 into/from Keble Road.
- 11 This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford – Cancer Research UK Race for Life) (Special Event) Order 2024 and shall have effect on 30 June 2024.
