



Emotional Development and Wellbeing



WHO Research: Emotional wellbeing at school is a better predictor of success in later life than academic attainment

- Strong teacher-child relationships based on trust and respect
 - SLT Level focus on wellbeing
 - Help vulnerable children to build friendships and social networks through activities


- Caregivers need to support learning
